6. DRONE FILM FESTIVAL POLAND 2024

Film & Photo Contest Regulations

§1 GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The organizer of the 6th Drone Film Festival Poland 2024 is the University of Lower Silesia, DSW in Wrocław, based at ul. Strzegomska 55, 53-611 Wrocław, Poland.

2. The directors of the Festival are its originators: Przemysław Artur Sowiecki and Piotr Paweł Żukowski.

3. The festival is created in cooperation with partners: SowiWeb Marketing Agency, Exdart -Images Without Borders, Images Without Borders Foundation, Pentagon Studio, Owl You Need - Portal of Creative and Active People, Independent Association of Creative People 10%Art, and the Film Club of the University of Lower Silesia DSW.

4. The festival will take place on May 18, 2024, at the University of Lower Silesia, DSW in Wrocław, ul. Strzegomska 55.

5. The festival is an open competition on a nationwide and international scale.

6. The aim of the Festival is to popularize the art of film and photography using photos taken with a drone, distinguish films of high artistic value, promote independent creativity, present new technologies, expand ecological awareness and attitudes, and promote Wrocław and Lower Silesia.

§2 CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

1. The competition participants may be: natural persons, non-governmental organizations and state institutions.

2. Employees of the Organizers, Partners and Sponsors and their immediate families (spouses, children, parents) cannot participate in the competition.

3. Two-person teams can participate: drone operator + camera operator.

4. Submitting videos and photos is free of charge.

5. The condition for accepting a film application is to send the work by e-mail along with a properly completed and signed application form and the GDPR clause. The signed documents should be sent as an attachment in PDF format.

6. Films and photographs can be submitted until **May 8, 2024**. The applicant will be informed electronically about the film's acceptance into the competition by May 12, 2024.

7. The authors of submitted films and photographs must have full copyrights to the music and film footage used or have a license to share the film. Music used in the film may be licensed under a Creative Commons license.

8. If the work is qualified for the final stage of the competition, the Organizer will contact you regarding additional information such as:

in the case of a film: film summary, stills, director's photo and a short biographical note. In the case of photography: photo of the director and a short biographical note.

§3 CATEGORIES AND COMPETITION'S RULES

1. To take part in the competition, you must select a maximum of two competition categories (e.g. two film categories, or one film plus one photographic category) from among the following:

a) HAPPINESS - Any interpretation of happiness, Film and photography category. Short movie with a length of 1 min. up to 5 minutes, completed min. 60% from aerial shots. From 1 to 3 photos.

b) NEW PERSPECTIVE New perspective of a place, object, situation, etc. Film category and photography. A short film with a length of 1 min. up to 5 minutes, completed min. in 60% of shots from the air. From 1 to 3 photos.

c) RACER EXTREME - Dynamics and speed using FPV racing drones. Film category. A short film with a length of 1 min. up to 5 minutes, made 100% from aerial shots.

d) AI - Using AI tools. Film and photography category. A short film of length from 1 min. up to 5 minutes, completed min. 60% from aerial shots. From 1 to 3 photos.

e) 360 - Film and photography category. A short film with a length of 1 min. up to 5 minutes, completed min. 60% from aerial shots. From 1 to 3 photos.

f) VERTICAL - The world vertically and on the phone. Film and photography category. A short film of length from 1 min. up to 5 minutes, completed min. 60% from aerial shots. From 1 to 3 photos.

2. You can submit a maximum of one work to the selected film category.

3. If you want to submit two films, please remember that each of them must be submitted separate category.

4. You can submit a maximum of 3 works to the photographic category.

5. Photographs of any capacity or a compressed film in .avi or .mp4 format of no size less than 100MB should be sent as a link, e.g. via <u>https://pl.filemail.com/</u> or <u>https://wetransfer.com</u> to the email address **dronefilmfest@gmail.com**. Please put it in the subject line of the email enter: "Drone Film Festival competition entry".

6. Films will be assessed based on the following criteria: degree of difficulty and originality of shots, plot and consistency of the film in form and content, image and sound editing.

7. The following criteria will be assessed: composition, aesthetics, originality, colors, subject matter of the work.

8. The organizer may not allow films and photographs to enter the competition in the event of: poor quality recording, content that is inconsistent with the subject of the competition and content that violates good manners and people's privacy third parties and critical institutions and infrastructure.

§4 AWARDS & JURY

1. Prizes - statuettes and diplomas - are awarded on the basis of the verdict of a specially appointed jury.

2. The jury will consist of specialists and lecturers from the University of Lower Silesia, DSW in Wrocław, and invited guests from the aviation and creative industries.

3. The Audience Award will also be awarded in a special plebiscite.

4. In addition to the prizes in individual main categories, prizes will be awarded for:

The best film and photo of "Talented Silesia".

The best special effects.

The best sound and music.

5. As part of the festival, the organizers will award an Honorary Award to people and institutions that support and promote drone film and photographic art, Polish independent cinema and young creators.

6. The festival prizes are non-financial. Award-winning creators will receive material prizes and gifts funded by the Festival's Sponsors and Partners.

7. Prizes not collected in person during the festival will be sent by post at the organizers' expense.

§5 ARRIVAL & ACCOMMODATION

1. The organizers invite the creators of the films and photographs presented in the competition to participate in a meeting with viewers during the festival (physically and online).

2. The presence of creators at the festival is optional.

3. The organizers do not provide places for the Creators of the presented films and photographs accommodation or reimbursement of travel costs.

§6 FESTIVAL PROMOTION

 The Organizer may make it available to the media free of charge for advertising and promotional purposes post fragments of submitted films and photographs on the Internet.
Award-winning films and photographs may be presented in partner cultural centers film throughout Poland. The list of partners is constantly updated. The conditions of the shows will be separate consulted with film creators and distributors.

§7 GDPR

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Regulation on the Protection personal data)

3. Persons submitting films and photographs to the competition declare that they have been informed that providing personal data is voluntary and that they have the right to view them and the possibility of correcting them.
