

„Drone Film Festival 2017” film and photo contest regulations

I. CONTEST GOALS

1. The main objective of the contest is to award the best and the most interesting aerial films and photographs of the works submitted according to the evaluation of the Jury and the audience.
2. Presenting the possibilities offered by aerial photography and filming.
3. The possibility of meeting operators, lovers of aerial photography, specialists in the field of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) and people nominated to fight for the „Crystal drones” during the final of **Drone Film Festival on 4th November 2017 in Conference Center at University of Lower Silesia in Wroclaw Strzegomska 55 Street.**

II. CONTEST ORGANIZER, PARTNERS AND SPONSORS

1. The contest is organised by SSLK 10%Art non-profit organisation.
2. The contest Partners are: University of Lower Silesia in Wrocław, Nokia Networks, Drony.net, SowiWeb, DroneStopColor, DronesPolska, Owl You Need - Portal of Creative & Active People, City Office Kudowa-Zdrój and Kłodzka TV.
3. Awards Sponsors are: Drony.net, Nokia Networks and University of Lower Silesia in Wrocław.
4. The whole list of partners and sponsors will be available on the festival website before the Big Final of the event.

III. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN CONTEST

1. Contest participant can be any natural person.
2. The competition is not open to employees of the Organizers, Partners and Sponsors, as well as their immediate family (spouse, children, parents).
3. Participation in the contest is free.
4. It is possible to participate in the contest in teams: drone operator + cameraman.

IV. CONTEST RULES

1. To enter the contest, the participant must select maximum of two competition categories:
 - **„City / Industrial” – film category**
 - a short film with a length of 1 - 5 min,
 - the main theme is city and industrialization,
 - film consisting of min. 60% of the air shots.
 - **„Nature” – film category**
 - a short film with a length of 1 - 5 min,
 - the main theme is nature,
 - film consisting of min. 60% of the air shots.

- **„Move” – film category**

- a short film with a length of 1 - 5 min,
- the main theme is move,
- film consisting of min. 60% of the air shots.

- **„New perspectives” – photo category**

- from 1 to 3 photographs,
- presenting what we know well in another way.

2. The following criteria will be assessed: montage of shots and sound, difficulty and originality of the shots, the plot and the consistency of the film in form and content.
3. Please send the compressed video format .avi or .mp4 or photos with a capacity of not less than 1MB as a link on <https://www.myairbridge.com> or <https://wetransfer.com> to the e-mail address dronefilmfest@gmail.com, by post, or personally on DVD or memory stick to the following address: **Drone Film Festival Office, Jerzego Kukuczki 12/14 Street, Wroclaw 50-570**. Shipping costs lies with the authors of works. The works and documents will not be returned. In the case of sending e-mail, please enter a title: "**Application to the Drone Film Festival competition.**"
4. The Organizer may not allow for the competition films and photographs in the case of: the poor quality of the recording, the content is incompatible to the competition theme and content that violates good manners.
5. For video and photos please attach the **completed application form**. Pattern cards for download at www.dronefilmfestival.eu.
6. One Participant may submit up to two categories of the competition.
7. The author agrees to disseminate their work by the festival's dff Wroclaw Organizers and declares that he agrees to the use of the image of people acting in the film.
8. If the work of third parties (eg. music) is used in the movie or photo, the author must include an obligation of owning the copyright to use the work or attach the appropriate permission or license (or alternatively a statement that the author declares that he has full rights of copyright to the contest works). **If the music used in the film is available for free for commercial use, place information about the author and the title track.**
9. The organizer will not use the music contained in the submitted work by the participant for their own purposes.
10. The organizer reserves the right to any use and publication of films for the purpose of information and promotion of **Drone Film Festival Wroclaw**, but always providing information about the author.
11. Organizer declares that he is not responsible for any possible injuries and damages caused by the film.
12. Applications will be accepted until **28 October 2017**. In the case of postal consignments, postmark up to 27 October 2017 will be decisive.
13. Sending of work constitutes acceptance of these rules.

V. EVALUATION AND AWARDS

1. The works will be judged by a Jury specified by the Organizer and by the audience.

2. The competition and its results will be announced on 4 November 2017 during the Big Final of **Drone Film Festival**, and the next day on the website www.dronefilmfestival.eu, the websites and social media of Organizers and Sponsors.
3. During the competition the prizes will be awarded, respectively for the first, second and third place in each category, with a total value of ten thousand PLN gross.
4. Prizes and main trophies except the small statuettes and diplomas must be collected personally / via a representative (after prior notice to the organizer) on the final day of the competition, that is 4 November 2017 during the Final Gala of Drone Film Festival or personally / via a representative in the office of the Association of Creative People 110% Art at University of Lower Silesia in Wrocław Strzegomska 47 Street to three months after the announcement of the results of the competition, that is 4 February 2018.
